ELIGIBILITY:

All contestants must provide a valid USJF, USJA or USA Judo card. Foreign contestants must have the proper ID from their home country. Membership registration will also be available at the site.

SCORING:

Modified Double Elimination (4 or more in a division) or Round Robin (3 or fewer in a division)

MATCH TIMES:

Senior Men & Women Open Divisions, 5 min.; Novice Divisions, 2 min. (see special rules); All other Divisions, 3 min.

RULES:

The current rules of the International Judo Federation (IJF) as modified.

1. GOLDEN SCORE will apply to ALL DIVISIONS.
2. NO Kansetsu waza allowed in Junior Division
3. Shime waza allowed for 13 yrs. of age and up
4. Kansetsu waza allowed in all senior divisions regardless of age. (Minimum age for Senior Divisions is 13.)
5. Pre-200e Medical Rules
6. White judogis are required. If you don't have a blue gi, you must bring your own white belt and blue belt. Blue belts or gis must be worn by the "blue" competitor and white belts or gi must be worn by the "white" competitor
7. Zori's or sandals are to be worn when the competitors are off the mat.
8. Must be in judo gi to receive your medal
9. **Special rules for the 4-12 Junior Novice Divisions:** These are two-minute matches that run to the full time limit. Scores are added up at the conclusion to determine the winner. There will be a three ippon limit. (These rules are designed to give novices as much mat time and experience as possible Novice competitors can also compete in more advanced divisions.
10. There may be **co-ed** competition for those 10 and under.

Weights are in kilograms; multiply by 2.2 for weight in pounds.
